 - Re-telling events and stories



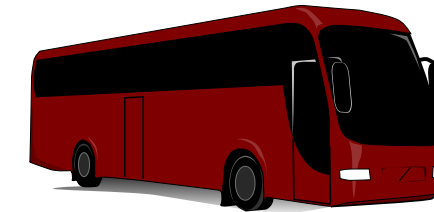
Physical development:
