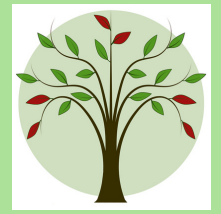


DORMANSLAND DAYS

Parent Coffee morning

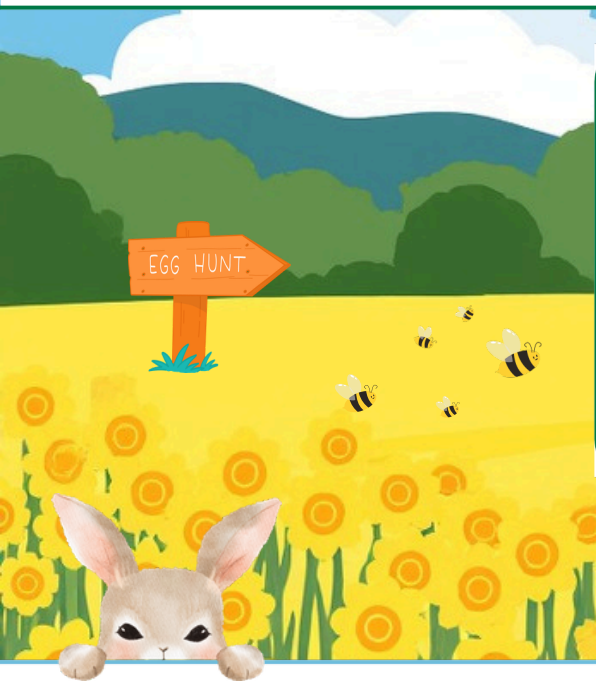
