The accounting year 2020-2021 started in September 2020 with an opening balance of £20,934.43

Income for the 2020-2021 year was £14,732,05, £6,732.05 from fundraising and £8000 achieved via grant, with expenses at £1393.

Outgoings for the year was £19,728.48 which included £16,000 on chrome books for the school, £1,133 for extra resources in Music, Science and English, library subscriptions £708 and £496 for the children's Christmas party and presents.

The total closing balance was £18,072, which forms the opening balance for the year 2021-2022.

There remains a ring fenced amount of £1,600 which was from an original grant from Gatwick Airport which must only be used for items to enhance the green outside areas, it is proposed that the sensory garden will use the rest of this amount.
