5<sup>th</sup> May will see the Circus coming to town!


Tickets are now on sale and will be sold throughout the community so do urge you to get your tickets quickly so that you do not miss out!

#### SO, WHAT'S BEEN RAISED AND WHAT'S BEEN SPENT?

**INCOME:** So far this year, with your help we've raised approximately £9,500



#### **OUTGOINGS (ACTUAL AND ANTICIPATED):**

Forest School – two terms	£	3,000
Computer System (annual fee)	£	700
New Boat Outside Play Area	£	5,500
Outside Play Storage and Equipment	£	600
New Tricycles for Reception and Y1	£	545
School Trip Subsidy	£	2,130
Interactive Whiteboards (grant+top up)	£	4,000

The money we raise also allows us to hold all PTA events as we need rolling funds to cover up front expenses.

The PTA also apply for grants from Dormansland Parish council and Tandridge District Council each year. We were fortunate to be the recipient of a grant from Dormansland Parish Council and the a donation from the Dormansland Carnival Committee which will support the ongoing funding for Forest School

#### **SO... WHAT NEXT?**

We have hot news off the press, following the recent Parent Forum Meeting it was decided that the next Big Ticket item the PTA is to raise money for will be install of a fully equipped kitchen to allow school lunches to be prepared on site, which will considerably increase the standard of the school lunches. Equally by increasing the size of the kitchen it will allow the school to fulfil the Food Technology part of the National Curriculum that until now they have not been able to do due to a lack of facilities. This is a long term project but one that will add considerable benefit to all.
