WHAT HAVE THE PTA BEEN UP TO LATELY?


The PTA team have organised the May Fair, Ice Lolly Fridays, and funded Music Appreciation Week, all of which the children loved.

SO, WHAT HAS BEEN RAISED AND WHAT HAS BEEN SPENT?

INCOME: In the Summer Term, we raised approximately £3,400 with your help:



Combined with the income from the previous terms of approximately £4,611, together we have raised approximately £8,000 this school year from PTA events.

OUTGOINGS:

From September 2017 to June 2018, the PTA has approved the following spending:

 School Trip Subsidy - Funded £10 per child towards clasterips. We do this each year, as long as we have the funded. 	· ·
 Class Allowance – each class teacher is offered £200 pe year to use for 'extras' to aid learning – 7 classes. Annua provided we have the funds. 	ŕ
3. Computer System (annual fee)	£700
 Cameras for classrooms x 8 - Cost approx. £670, part funded by a grant the PTA applied for of £300. Now purchased and being used in school. 	£365

5. PTA Christmas treat - Treasure Island theatre production £270 by The Flying Pizza Company. Took place in January and enjoyed by all!

6. Class resources - maths. £1,400

7. Science week £490

8. Music week £230

9. New Boat Play Area for the playground. £4,000

10.End of Year treat. The inflatable obstacle course is back! £545 (on 18th July)

TOTAL: £11,480

The PTA funds we raise also allow us to hold all PTA events as we need rolling funds to cover up front expenses.

The PTA also apply for grants each year for the benefit of the school children.

WHAT NEXT?

As mentioned in our last Newsletter, we have been working closely with the school to assess the best use for the funds we have raised together. We have now agreed to fund the purchase and installation of a new boat in the playground at £4,000. The current boat is rotten and needs to be removed as soon as possible. The children, of all ages, love this boat and we hope to have it replaced very soon.

The trim trail has been reopened for now but does need significant work and money spent on it, well in excess of £20k. The school is considering all options at present.
