School Updates	Updated a-z-parent forum members to review content of booklet
Reception	<p>Do children have access to water bottles during the day? Water bottles should only contain water, as children given juice to sip on throughout the day, dramatically increases their chances for tooth decay. Children are given free access to these throughout the day, and instructed to drink from them at many points. If a child drinks all of their water, it is refilled.</p> <p>If my child has a packed lunch, do they get a drink? All hot meals children are provided with water in a cup at lunchtimes. Packed lunch children should have a drink in their lunchbox, if they do not then a cup is provided.</p> <p>Sometimes milks runs out and my child doesn't get any? All children are entitled to milk until they turn 5, from this point it must be paid for if you would like your child to continue. Sometimes we may not have milk on the first day of term.</p> <p>Summer hats being stored in a box spreads nits. This does not increase the spread, unfortunately young children's heads are close to each other all day. <u>Children with hair longer than collar length must have their hair tied back.</u> We would encourage regular monitoring of your child. They climb from one person's hair to another's. Head lice: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • can't fly, jump or swim • are very unlikely to be spread by objects like hats, combs and pillows • don't have a preference for dirty, clean, short or long hair • only affect people • can't be caught from animals </p>
